Navigating your community during coronavirus

As the coronavirus outbreak causes disruptions to daily life, understanding how to safely navigate in our communities is of paramount importance. Safety extends outside our homes to our means of transport, commercial businesses and social lives. Above all, remain connected to messages on community movement in your area as dictated by local authorities, especially if you are in an area of quarantine.

Transport

Whether you travel in a private vehicle or through a form of public transport, always maintain good hygienic practices. Do not continue travel if at any time local authorities recommend or declare a stop to such transit.



Clean your hands immediately after taking any public transport or operating a vehicle



If you own a vehicle, regularly disinfect surfaces such as door handles, steering wheel, or instrument panel controls



Open windows and/or increase ventilation through air conditioning

Commercial Businesses

Even during times of restricted movement, the need to visit businesses such as a pharmacy or grocery store may arise. Consider the following when visiting such public establishments.



Wash hands thoroughly after any contact interaction in a commercial business, such as payment for goods, handling of products such as meat or produce, etc.



Consider visiting businesses during non-peak times to avoid crowds when possible



Use delivery services or online shopping if available to minimize contact

Social Gatherings

To the extent that small gatherings remain safe or appropriate, consider the following safe practices while meeting with friends or family:



Stop handshaking, kisses, hugs, or any other form of contact greeting



Consider limiting your attendance to smaller events, and not attending large scale events altogether



Discourage the sharing of food or drinks
